6) Follow Step-4, fill up the subjects for which you want to apply

7A: Those who will be opting for Online Payment, Click on the “Online Payment” and proceed accordingly.

7B: Those who will be paying OFFLINE, download the Bank Challan, Print it, Pay requisite fees through the branches (located within West Bengal) of United Bank of India.

8) Log in again with the registration number / username and password to fill the Bank Challan No & Date and Submit.

9) After final submission take the print out of the submitted form, paste photograph, signed in appropriate places.

1. Eligibility criteria for admission in B.A. (Hons.)

Candidates passing Higher Secondary Examination conducted by West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent board/council (List of the board/councils are listed below) in the year (2015/2016/2017) are eligible for apply for Honours course in 1. Bengali, 2.English, 3. History, 4. Philosophy, 5. Political Science 6. Sanskrit, 7.Santali, 8.Sociology provided that the candidate must have passed in 5(Five)/4(Four) (where applicable) recognized subjects including at least one language subject with at least 45% marks in aggregate or 50% marks in subjects or related subjects in the qualifying examination.

2. Eligibility criteria for admission in B.A. (General.)

Candidates passing Higher Secondary Examination conducted by West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent Board/Council (List of the Board/Councils are listed below) in the year 2015/2016/2017 are eligible to apply for General course with subjects 1. **Bengali**, 2.**English**, 3.**History**, 4. **Philosophy**, 5. **Political Science**, 6.**Santali**, 7.**Sociology**, 8.**Sanskrit** provided that the candidate must have passed in 5(Five)/4(Four) (where applicable) recognized subjects including at least one language subject.

Candidates passed the Vocational Course can apply in B.A. General Course only

3..Eligibility criteria for admission in B.Sc. (General.) :

Candidates passing Higher Secondary Examination conducted by West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent board/council (List of the board/councils are listed below) in the year (2015/2016/2017) are eligible to apply for General course with subjects 1. **Physics**, 2.**Chemistry**, 3.**Biology**, provided that the candidate must have passed in 5(Five)/ 4(Four) (where applicable) recognized subjects including at least one language subject.

N.B.: A CANDIDATA PASSING 10+2 LEVEL BEFORE 2015 WITH ABOVE MENTIONED CRITERIA CAN ALSO APPLY AFTER GETTING SPECIAL PERMISSION FROM THE SECRETARY, U.G. COUNCIL VIDYASAGAR UNIVERSITY, MIDNAPORE.

Merit Point Calculation:

Merit Point = X+Y for Honours Course applicants

X =10 percent of marks in aggregate in the 10+2 level exam counting the total marks of the *Best of Five Subjects* among the subjects studied excluding the marks of environmental studies / science.

Y= marks obtained in the applied subject as Hons, If that subject is not studied, consider the marks of one subject as indicated in the table:

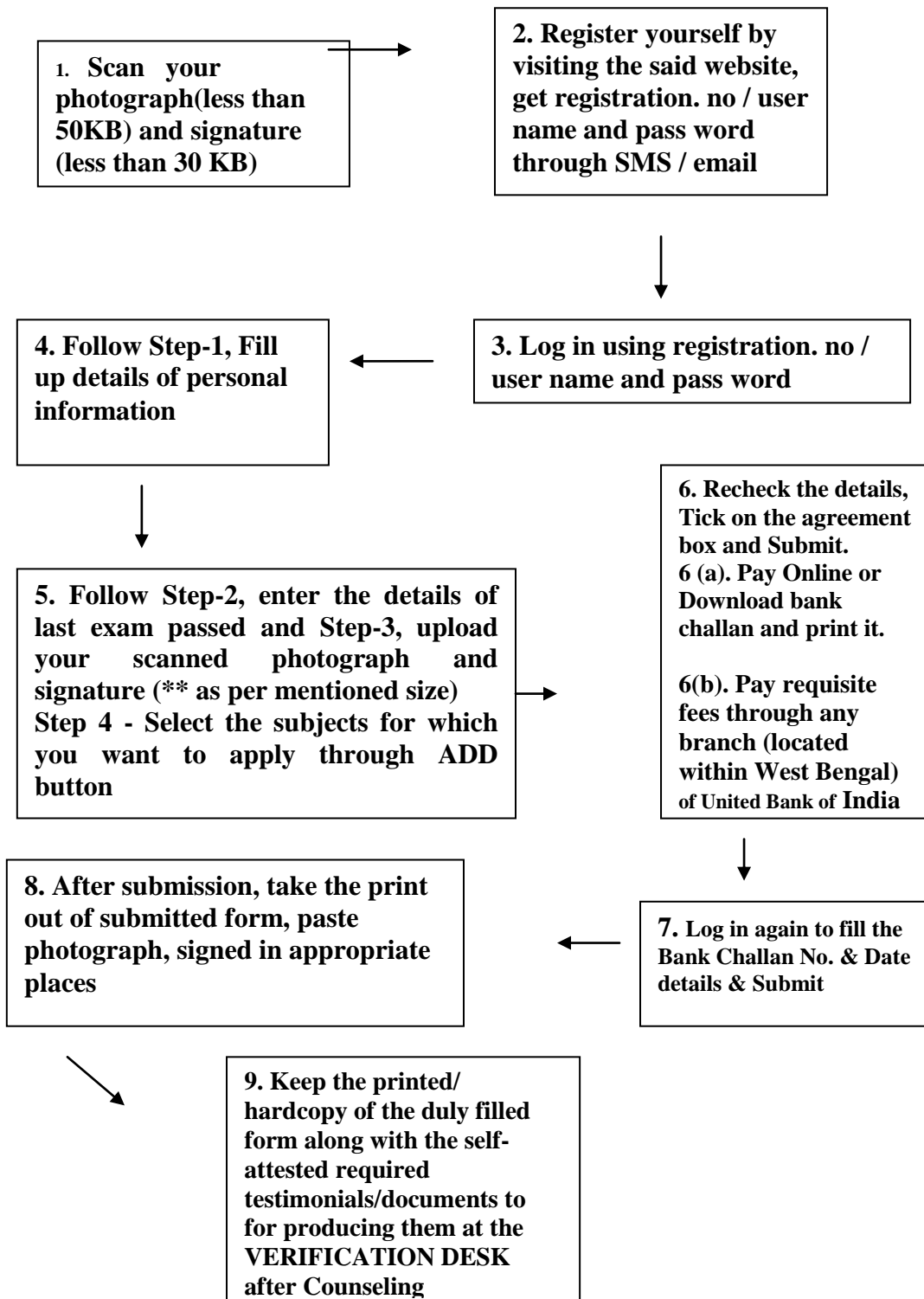

Note: If more candidates score same merit point, preference will be given to higher Y, in this way, if more candidates have same merit points and same Y; preference will be given to higher marks in 1st Language.

Merit Point = Z for Pass Course applicants

Z: for the applicants of the General Course, the merit point will be calculated counting the total marks of the *Best of Five Subjects* among the subjects studied excluding the marks of environmental studies / science.

HOW TO APPLY: (in Words)

For filling up the on-line application form carefully follow the subsequent steps:

Before filling up, keep the scanned copy of your Photograph (30/20 KB) and Signature (less than 30 KB) with you.

1. Go to the ADMSSION HOME PAGE
2. CLICK ON “REGISTER NOW”: Register yourself by filling up the Basic information like Name, Date of Birth, Mobile Number, E-mail.
3. Get an SMS/ E-mail containing your Registration Number and Password; Keep them for future reference.
4. Enter into Your Account: Click on “Apply Now”
5. Step I of your form filling up process: Enter your personal details in the relevant fields & Continue
6. Step II of your form filling up process: Enter your Higher Secondary / Equivalent Examination details in the relevant fields & Continue
7. Step III of your form filling up process: Upload your Scanned Photograph as per mentioned size and Signature & Continue
8. Step IV of your form filling up process: Select your Course and Subjects: You can apply for 2 Honours Subjects and the General Subjects: you can do it by clicking on “Add to List” & Continue
9. Edit if necessary, Tick on the Agreement Box and Submit & Continue
10. Step V of your form filling up process: Either PAY ONLINE or Download the Bank Challan & Get the Print of the same.
