Energy conservation policies at college campuses include the following measures:

Landscaping: Use trees and plants to create a cool atmosphere on campus, and to build awareness around the environment.

Awareness: Create awareness among students and staff about energy conservation. For example, organize energy campaigns.

Waste management: Develop a systematic waste management mechanism.

Rainwater harvesting: Develop a rainwater harvesting unit.

Monitoring and Reporting: The policy encompasses systems for monitoring and reporting energy consumption, performance metrics, and progress towards energy conservation goals.

Compliance and Regulations: The scope extends to ensuring compliance with relevant energy conservation regulations, standards, and best practices, as well as striving to exceed compliance requirements where feasible.
